It is strongly recommended that the form, completed and duly signed, is returned <b>at least 10 working days before</b> the proposal submission deadline. Applicant will be sent a written notification of their eligibility status. Changes of acronym and budget provided in the <a href="#">pre-submission eligibility check</a> are not allowed. After the NEURON Cofund 2 peer review process has been completed and the final (scientific) ranking list has been established and endorsed by the Call Steering Committee, the Ministry of Health will invite the principal investigators of the projects approved for funding to enter the formal national negotiations (according to national regulations).
